Now another heart warming story from the home. New guidance from the government allows each care home resident to receive visits from one family member or loved one. One of the first residents to be reunited with her daughter in person is Brenda Evans, aged 91. She said: "It was lovely to see my daughter Holly once again and hold her hand. It's so nice to be in the same room together."

The COVID pandemic has shown us that we should never take those small comforts for granted.
