Promoting Freemasonry through local community events


Local Community Festivals and Fairs are a great way for Lodges and Masonic Centres to make their presence

The next ride of the SMCA takes place this Sunday 12th September. The starting point is Radstock's Waterloo Road Car Park BA3 3ER at 8.45 (next to the museum). The ride will follow the national cycle network two tunnels route to Midford station. Then to the Kennet and Avon Canal at the Dundas aqueduct where the canal crosses high above the river Avon and the Great Western Railway. (photo left) We reach the centre of the City of Bath via the canal towpath. Then heading to the western outskirts of Bath we pick up the two tunnel route back to Radstock. Total distance is 42Km through some fantastic North Somerset countryside and the Georgian city of Bath.
