Pakistan flood victims receive support from Freemasons


Torrential monsoon rains have caused the worst flood in Pakistan's recent history, leaving millions of people displaced with no access to shelter, food or clean water.

More than a thousand people, including hundreds of children, have lost their lives in the disaster and the MCF, in partnership with the British Red Cross and UNICEF, is providing emergency relief to the survivors with a £30,000 grant, made on behalf of Freemasonry.

The money will provide clean drinking water, emergency food relief for hundreds of households, tents to provide basic shelter or mosquito nets to protect flood survivors from malaria and dengue fever.
