**Lodge Support Funding totalling £1,020:**

**Nyanza Lodge 1197** donation of **£1,600** - Lodge Support Funding added **£500:**

- **ARK** (Acts of Random Kindness) near **Crewkerne**, offer a range of indoor & outdoor experiences, activities, and support services to improve health & wellbeing by enabling participation and inclusion.

**Progressive Science Lodge 5007** donations of **£840** - Lodge Support Funding added **£420:**

- **£210** each for the **Somerset & Dorset Air Ambulance**, and **Yeovil** Food Bank.

**St Bernard Lodge 5361** donation of **£200** - Lodge Support Funding added **£100**

- Village agents scheme, supporting individuals in **West Somerset** with no other access to support.

**The Somerset Masonic Charity fund held with the Somerset Community Foundation - £2,400.**

**£ 600** for **Actiontrack** who provide creative projects, sessions and workshops for young people across the county and at its studio space in Taunton. They run 40 2-hour creative sessions for young people not in education, employment or training (NEET) in **Taunton**.

**£ 600** for Citizen Advice **West Somerset** who receive no funding at all from a national Citizen Advice charity and are expected to raise all their own income.

**£ 600** for **Yeovil** Shopmobility who provide powered scooters, and powered and manual wheelchairs, to enable people with limited mobility to shop and use other pleasure/leisure facilities in Yeovil.

**£ 600** for Zone Youth which is a community group that was set up in 2016 to ensure a youth work provision was available in **Burnham-on-Sea** following the demise of the County Council's youth service.
